

Confined Space Rescue Team Rigging Sector

Roles & Responsibilities

- 1) To do a proper site survey and locate the most appropriate means of entry and egress for the Entry Team.
- 2) To establish a secure site for proper rigging:
 - a) free from entanglement hazards.
 - b) Free from sharp corners, edges or equipment.
- 3) Identify and assemble appropriate equipment.
- 4) Ensure all members assisting with rigging understand the system to be set-up.
- 5) Locate proper anchor points.
- 6) Coordinate rigging with Entry Sector.
- 7) Check ALL rigging equipment before entry is made.

Equipment

- 1) Tarp(s) for equipment.
- 2) Tripod and rigging as needed.
- 3) Full body harnesses for Entry and Back-up Teams.
- 4) All rigging bins.
- 5) Ropes.
- 6) Backboard, Stokes, SKED.
- 7) Portable radio.
- 8) PPE for Entry and Back-up Teams
 - a) Nomex coveralls?
 - b) Helmets w/ lights.
 - c) Eye protection.
 - d) Gloves.
 - e) Hearing protection?
- 9) Sector notebook.

Duties

- 1) To be in charge of all aspects of rigging.
- 2) To ensure rigging is done safely and efficiently.
- 3) To report to Operations and Entry Sector when rigging is complete.
